- 9th and 10th centuries
- On two Neighbouring islands in Lake Mälaren, in the Municipal of Ekerö
- Archaeological complex of Viking-age trading
- Influenced history of Scandinavia
- The first Christian congregation in Sweden







The Royal Domain of Drottningholm

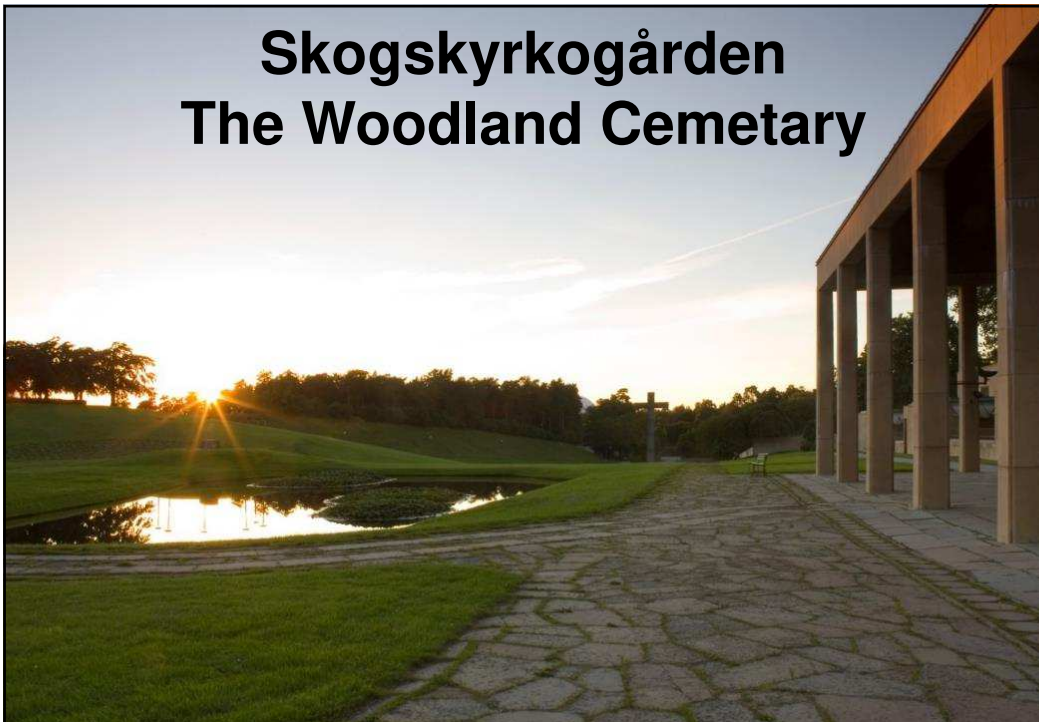
- On an island in Lake Mälaren near Stockholm

- Chinese pavilion
- Inspired by the Palace of Versailles

Skogskyrkogården

- Created 1917 - 1920
- Two architects, Asplund and Lewerentz
- Blends vegetation and architectural elements
- A landscape that is finely adapted to its function
- Influenced Cemeteries in many Countries
